CHANGE TO LUCKY 7 TICKET PRICING

On July 29, 2020, Governor Sununu signed HB 1245 into law. This legislation includes language (provided below) that changes the allowable price for a Lucky 7 ticket to either \$0.50 or \$1.00. This change took effect upon signing (July 29, 2020).

RSA 287-E:20, II. The price of any lucky 7 ticket pack or ticket card shall be either \$0.50 or \$1.00, provided that at any location where a charitable organization offers \$1.00 tickets for sale the charitable organization shall also offer \$0.50 tickets for sale.

WHAT THIS CHANGE MEANS FOR MANUFACTURERS AND DISTRIBUTORS

All licensed Lucky 7 manufacturers and distributors must immediately stop selling \$0.25 ticket deals.

We also ask that licensed distributors accept the return of any unopened \$0.25 Lucky 7 deals from the charitable organizations they serve.

WHAT THIS CHANGE MEANS FOR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS

Effective immediately, charitable organizations are not to open any new \$0.25 Lucky 7 ticket deals. Charitable organizations should contact their Lucky 7 distributor to coordinate the return of these unopened deals for a refund.

Charitable organizations may continue to sell tickets from currently open deals until midnight on December 31, 2020. The sale of any \$0.25 Lucky 7 tickets after this date is strictly prohibited.

If a charitable organization chooses to sell \$1.00 Lucky 7 tickets, it must also offer \$0.50 tickets for sale.
