Coming Soon: New Badge Printer

Within the next couple of weeks we will be receiving a new badge printer. We do know that currently the Game Operator and Game Operator Employer badges tend to fade and do not last the full year of the license. Our new printer will have lamination which will help prevent the ink from fading. We may have to tweak the designs of the licenses to match with the new software, but we will notify you of any changes that do happen.

Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Requests

Over the past few months we have received numerous requests for financial and licensing data from GOE's and gaming lobbyists. Many of these requests fall under the Freedom of Information Act and we have been tasked with logging the data that we provide to the public. In order to keep track, we ask that you please send any and all requests for Games of Chance and Bingo/Lucky 7 data to Britni Halvorsen and she will forward it to the appropriate person for completion. Once we receive a request for information, the NH Lottery Commission has 5 days to respond stating that we have received the request and if applicable, will give you an estimated completion date. Please keep in mind that some FOIA requests cannot be fulfilled due to confidentiality rules. Also, the Commission is only responsible for providing reports/documents that we currently have within our database. We are not required to create new reports/documents that are not part of our normal business process.

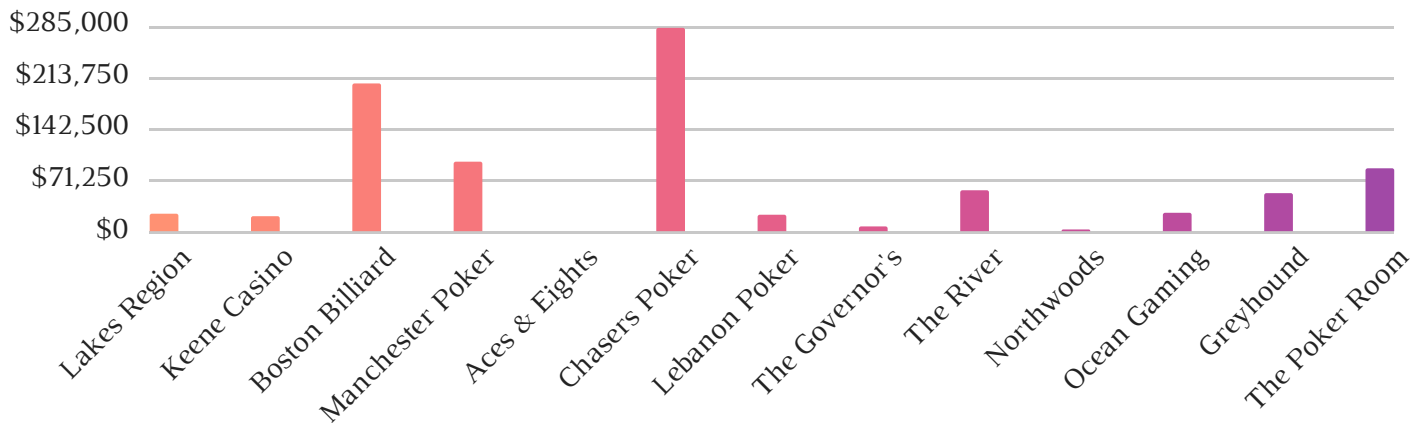
