APRIL

BINGO PARI RULE OF THE MONTH:

Pari 1003.03(b)(2) – States that one of the licensing requirements for a commercial bingo hall is to submit copies of all rental and or lease agreements in effect related to the use of the premises for the conduct of bingo games.

LUCKY 7 PARI RULE OF THE MONTH:

Pari 1106.02(a)(1) – States that lucky 7 deals shall be assembled so that winning tickets are placed randomly throughout each deal.

GAMES OF CHANCE LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7206.03(d)(3) – States that the amount of rent, goods and services charged shall not be greater than the charitable organization's share of the gross proceeds for the license period.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC

On March 16th, Governor Sununu issued "Emergency Order #2." which requires all restaurants and bars to serve patrons by takeout, delivery, and drive-through methods only, and prohibits gatherings of 50 people or more for social, spiritual and recreational activities. The New Hampshire Lottery Commission (NHLC) interprets such activities to include charitable gaming events (bingo, lucky 7, games of chance, etc.).

In an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19 in New Hampshire, the NHLC expects that all gaming events will be cancelled, including those with fewer than 50 people. To keep track of closings, we are requesting that all charitable organizations, halls and game rooms send an email that states how long they will be closed. At this time, we are keeping track of all closings due to COVID-19 and will determine a method for refunds/credits at a later time. Please send your closure email to the following individuals:


