2020 FACILITY AND GOE LICENSES

It's that time of year! All 2019 Facility and Game Operator Employer (GOE) licenses will be expiring December 31, 2019. Every licensed game room should've received a letter in September in regards to renewing their licenses for the new year. If you did not receive a renewal letter, please contact Britni Halvorsen at britni.halvorsen@lottery.nh.gov.

Please keep in mind, once your 2020 Facility and GOE licenses have been approved and issued, you will then receive the approved 2020 charitable organization licenses for your location.

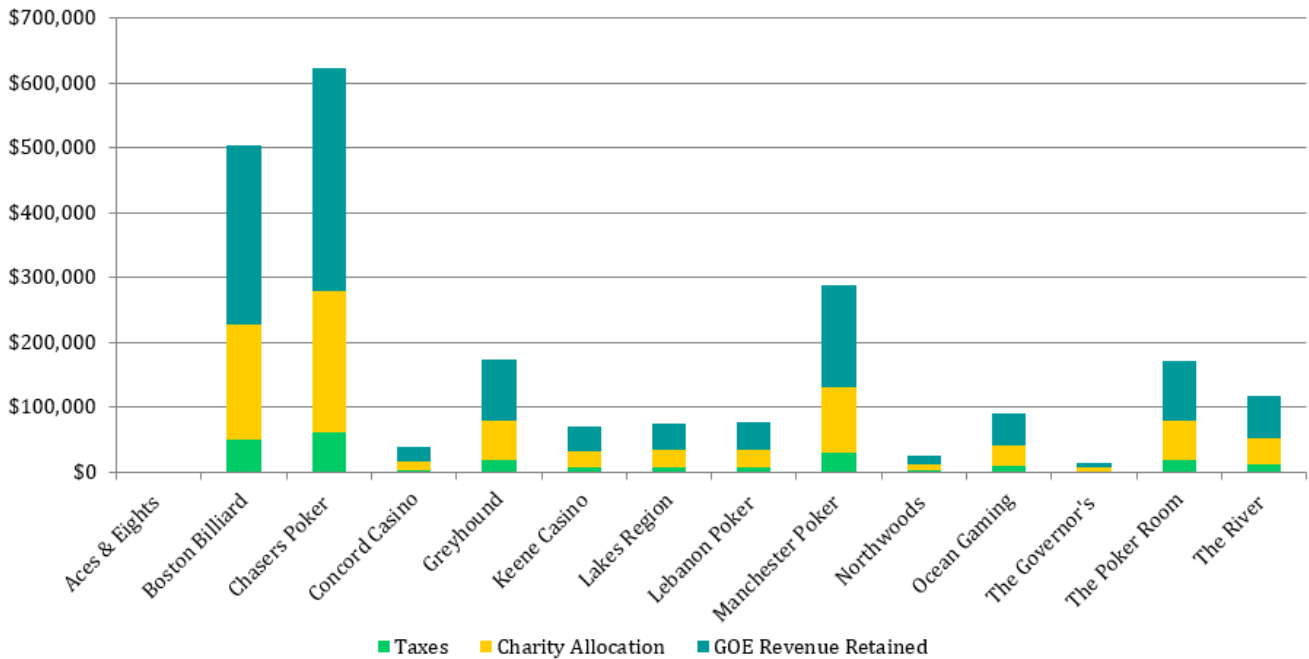
