Just a friendly reminder that all criminal background documents (notarized form, fingerprints and check for State Police) need to be submitted to the NH Lottery with the applications. We will then forward the documents to State Police for processing. Please do not submit these documents to State Police or any Police Department directly.

When filling out the State Revenue invoices and monthly financial reports, please remember to use the Charitable Organizations full name. We have a number of American Legion's, Kiwanis Clubs, VFW's, etc. so it is very important to not abbreviate. It is imperative that the full name of the organization is listed on these documents. 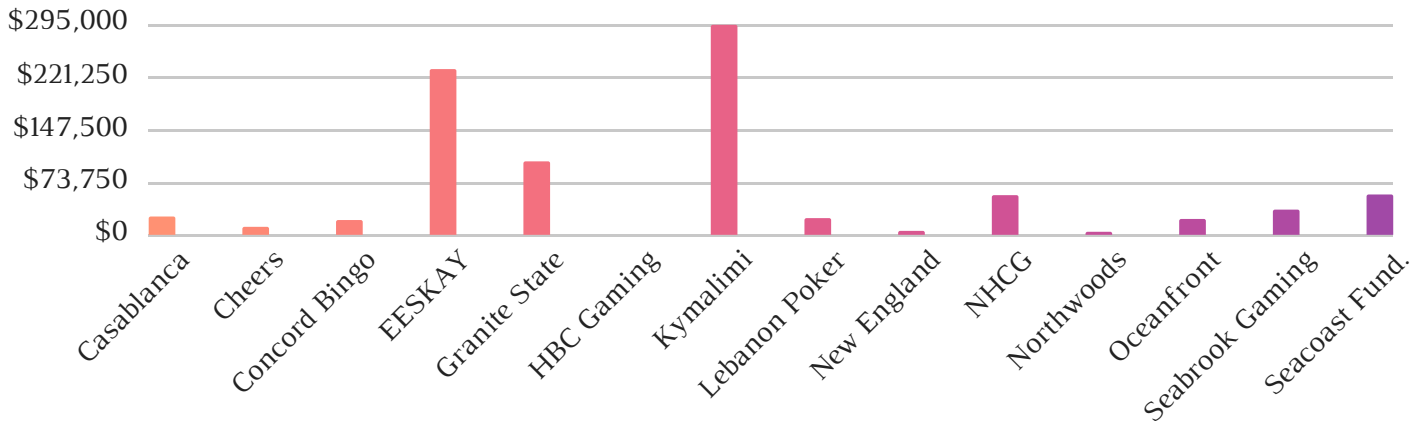

Pari 1203.06 (a)

States that when a Game Operator wants to work for more than one Game Operator Employer, the Game Operator will need to submit a new application and licensing fee to obtain a separate badge for the room in which they are applying for.
