Pari 1007.04(a) - States that a shared carryover coverall game shall only be simulcast using audio and video technologies that have been approved by the NH Lottery Commission.


LUCKY 7 PARI RULE OF THE MONTH:

Pari 1104.03(c) - States that a license shall be valid only for the activities, location, dates and times as listed on the license.

GAMES OF CHANCE LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7206.04(a)(1) - States that all agreements between a charitable organization and a game operator employer shall be enacted using the "Standard Form of Agreement for Games of Chance" form.




INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOSURES


HOLIDAY CLOSURES
