TEMPORARY BADGES

Beginning July 1, 2019, temporary badges will only be available to any "new" Secondary game operators. We will no longer provide temporary badges for Secondary game operator renewal licenses or any Primary game operators. To help operators avoid lapsing, the New Hampshire Lottery Commission will send expiration reminders the first of the month beginning on May 1, 2019. Please inform all of your game operators of this change so that we can better help them when we receive their paperwork.

DEALER ADD-ONS

Any dealer add-ons MUST comply with our laws and rules. Key points about dealer add-ons to remember are:

1. Dealer add-on purchases must be included in the total funds collected from players;
2. Dealer add-ons must comply with the player spending limits set by statute;
3. the charity must receive 35% of the revenue that remain after prizes are paid; and
4. Dealer add-on "tips" given to dealers must come from the GOE's share of the revenue.


