## Documentation Displayed in Gaming Area

All game rooms need to have certain documentation available for the public to access. These documents are:

- Charitable organization's current Games of Chance license
- Game schedule of games being played
- House rules that have been approved by the NH Lottery.

All 3 documents need to be displayed in the immediate area where Games of Chance is conducted.

## Licensing & Enforcement - Auditing Team

The NH Lottery Commission recently expanded the auditing team to five members (pictured right). In addition to an annual site-visit rotation, the auditing team conducts monthly desk reviews, periodic check-ins and full audits for all licensed game rooms.


