This box does not indicate the members that are able to sign the affidavit form. Those individuals do not need to get a Criminal Background check. To sign the affidavit, the individual only needs to be a bona-fide member of the organization.

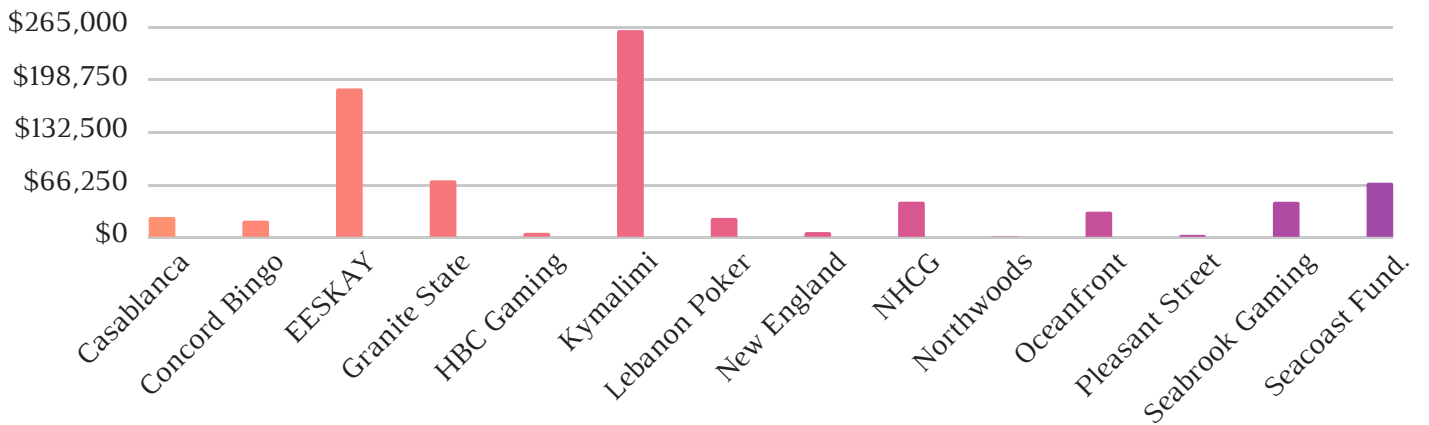
