BINGO LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7003.08(a)(2) - Charitable organization licenses shall expire on the last day of the month for which the license was issued, or for annual licenses, the last day of the year in which it was issued.

LUCKY 7 LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7108.02(e)(1) - All application software (for all electronic lucky 7 dispensing devices) shall be wholly owned free and clear and without any further obligation or condition by any entity other than the licensed manufacturer.

GAMES OF CHANCE LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7203.04(a) - Any individual who is responsible for conducting, managing, supervising, directing or running the games of chance on behalf of a charitable organization shall obtain a primary game operator license.

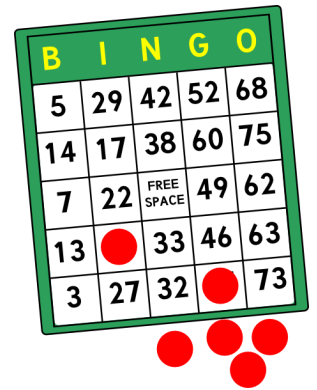

2021 BINGO & LUCKY 7 LICENSES

It's time to renew Bingo and Lucky 7 (L7) licenses for 2021!

Copies of our new applications and other documents pertaining to Bingo/L7 can be found on our website. Please note, each of the following documents

MUST be submitted with the first application for 2021 game dates (i.e. your January Bingo/L7 applications). Failure to submit all required documents and payments will delay the processing of your application. Supporting documents to be included with your January applications are:

- Documentation confirming the organization's federal tax-exempt status;
- Documentation confirming the organization's registration with NH Secretary of State;
- Documentation confirming the organization's registration with NH Charitable Trusts Unit;
- A letter of charitable purpose;
- A current "Bingo/Lucky 7 Gaming Operations Participant List";
- A copy of the organization's Bingo and /or L7 house rules;
- A copy of the organization's Bingo program (game schedule); and
- Copies of any contracts or agreements for gaming related services.

Once on file, these documents do not need to be resubmitted with subsequent applications for 2021 game dates. Questions in regards to these topics? Call Irene Rondeau at (603)230-3101.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/HOLIDAY CLOSURES

The winter and holiday season is almost here and we want to remind all game operator employers (GOE's) that if you are closing due to any weather related matters or for any holidays, please send an email to Britni Halvorsen at (britni.n.halvorsen@lottery.nh.gov). Not all game rooms are closed during holidays such as Christmas day and Thanksgiving day so it is very important that you give the commission an advance notice if you are going to be closed on a certain holiday. If a GOE ends up closing due to weather related matters and they have a charitable organization licensed for that day, the GOE must notify the commission of such closing by the next business day. The organization will receive a refund check in the mail for the closed date(s) but please keep in mind, if the GOE does not send an email by the next business day, the organization will not receive a refund and the day will be marked as a "game date played".

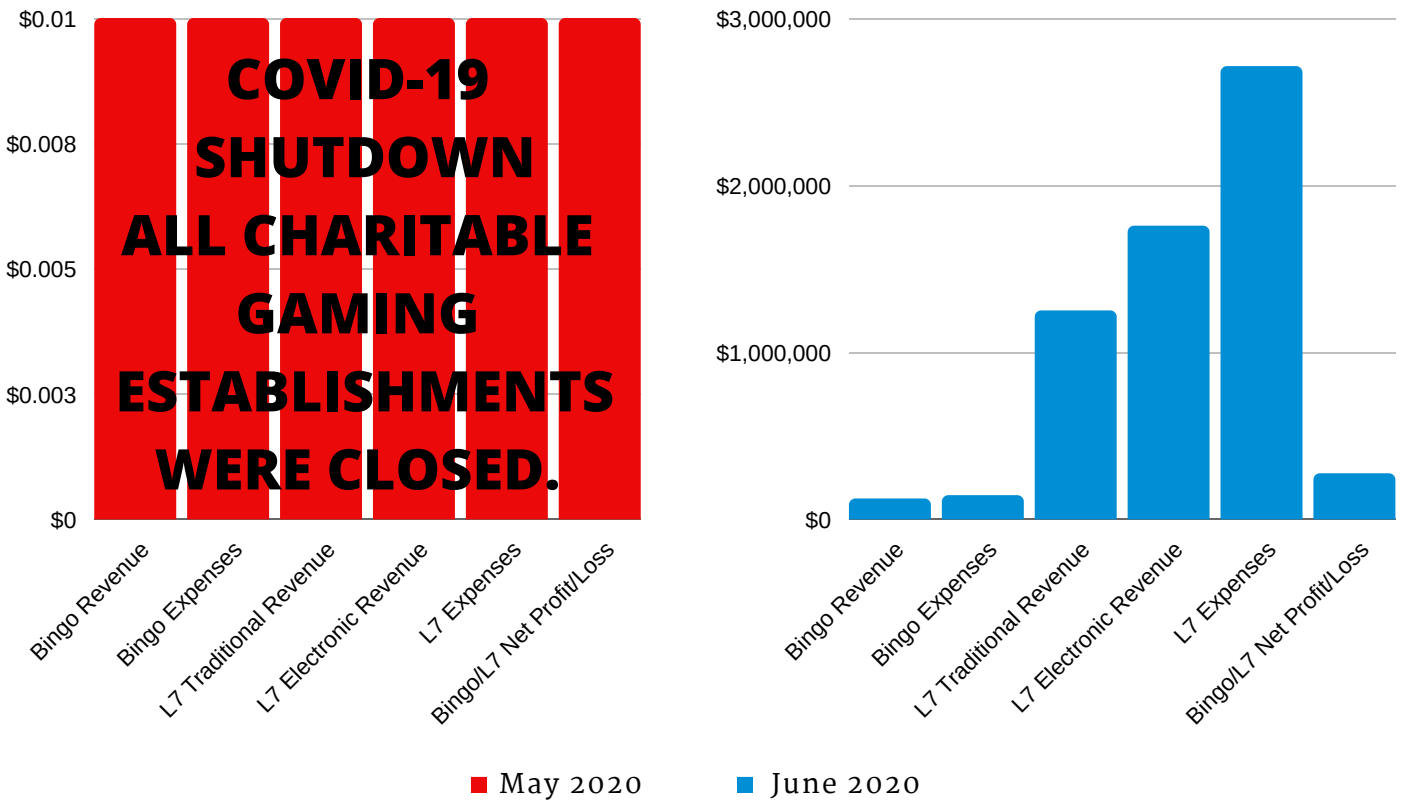

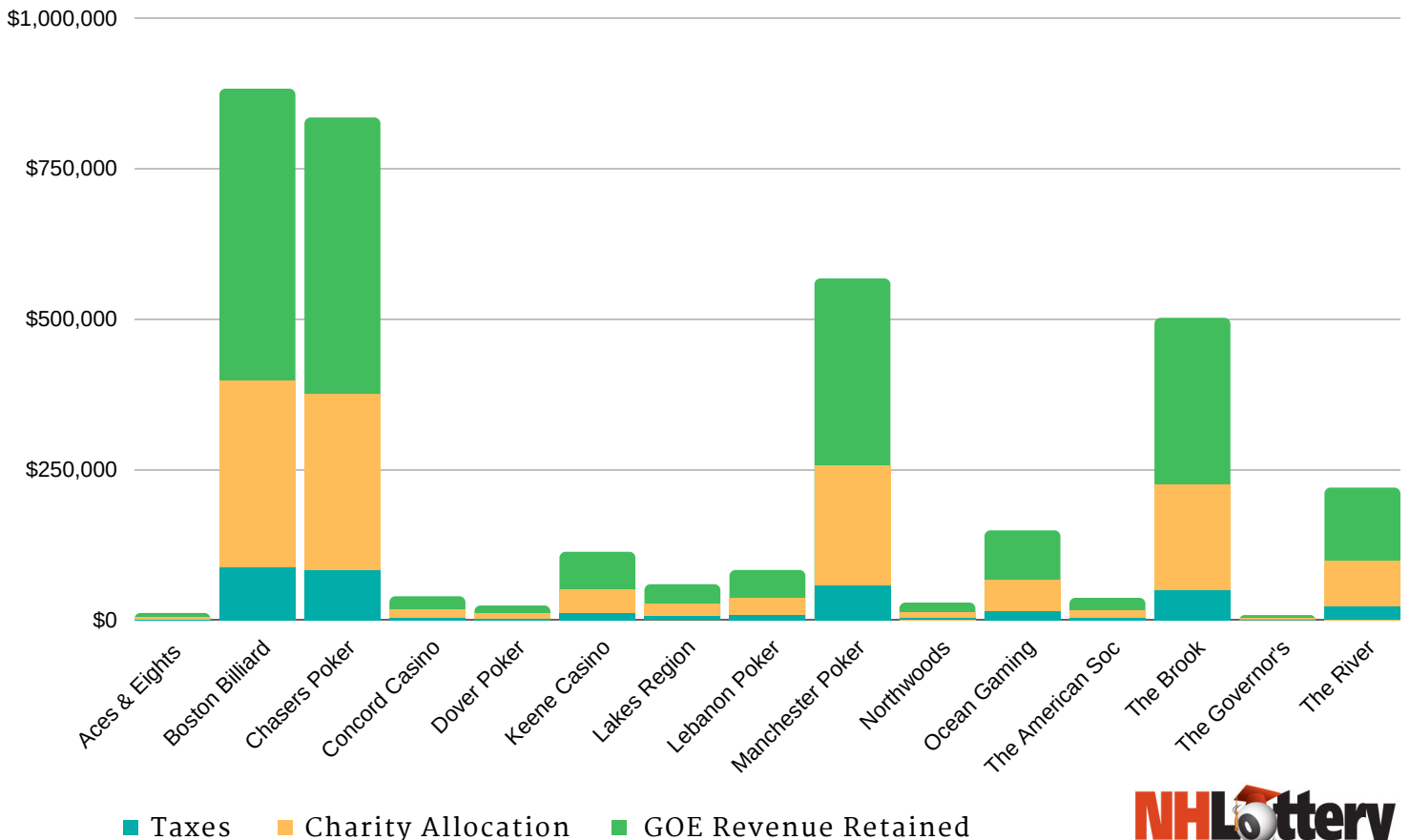
