BINGO LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7003.07(c)(2) - A charitable organization license shall permit no more than 10 game dates of bingo in one calendar month; and in no more than one town or city which has authorized bingo games under RSA 287-E:27.

LUCKY 7 LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7103.03(j) - The gaming consultant shall submit all amended agreements to the commission prior to the agreement going into effect, and attest in writing that the agreement complies with the requirements set forth in this part.

GAMES OF CHANCE LOT RULE OF THE MONTH:

Lot 7203.07(e) - For a GOC facility license, the applicant shall ensure that the facility complies with all applicable laws and building codes, including compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA).

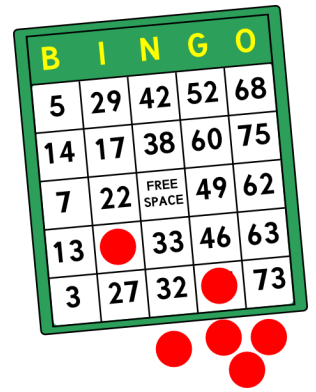

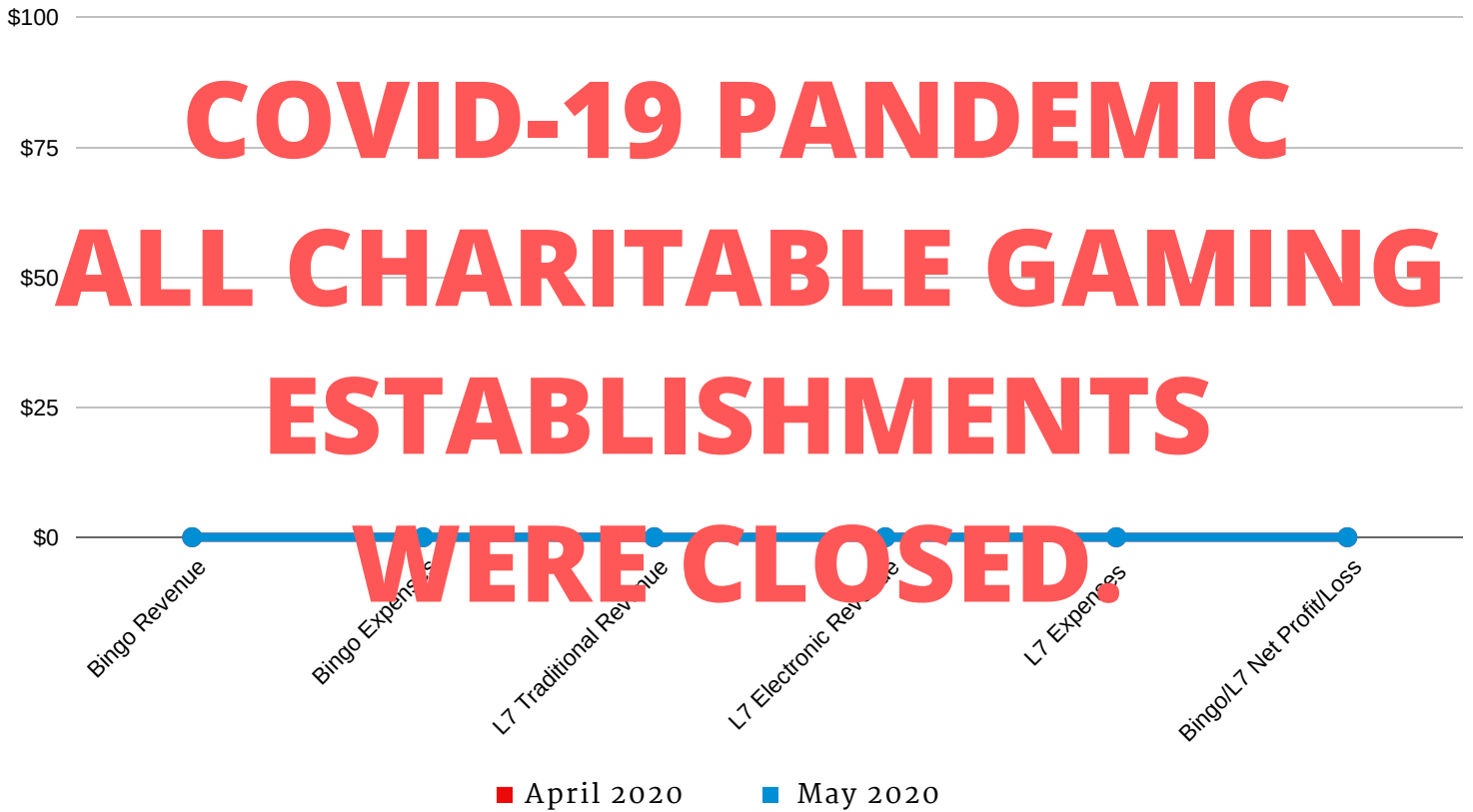
