2019 Facility & GOE Licenses:

This month, all Game Operator Employer's will be receiving emails in regards to their upcoming 2019 yearly licenses. Please pay close attention, as some information may be different from last years application process.

Quick Tips:

Monthly Financial Reports:

RSA 287-D:19, II(d) says that the charity's share of the revenue after prizes and rent is paid cannot be less than zero, which means that at the end of the month, the charity can never owe any money to the GOE. So, for example, if the charity's cut of the revenue is \$400 before rent is paid, and the rent is \$750, the charity does not owe the Game Operator Employer the remaining rent of \$350 because it would violate RSA 287-D:19, II(d).

Internal Control Policies & Procedures:

It's almost renewal time for your Game Operator Employer licenses! To ensure your compliance with Pari 1206.08(a), this year we are asking each room to submit a copy of their Internal Controls with their license application. Internal Controls are a critical component of any game room as they ensure control over the gaming operation by discouraging and protecting against illicit behavior and safeguarding the integrity of the games.

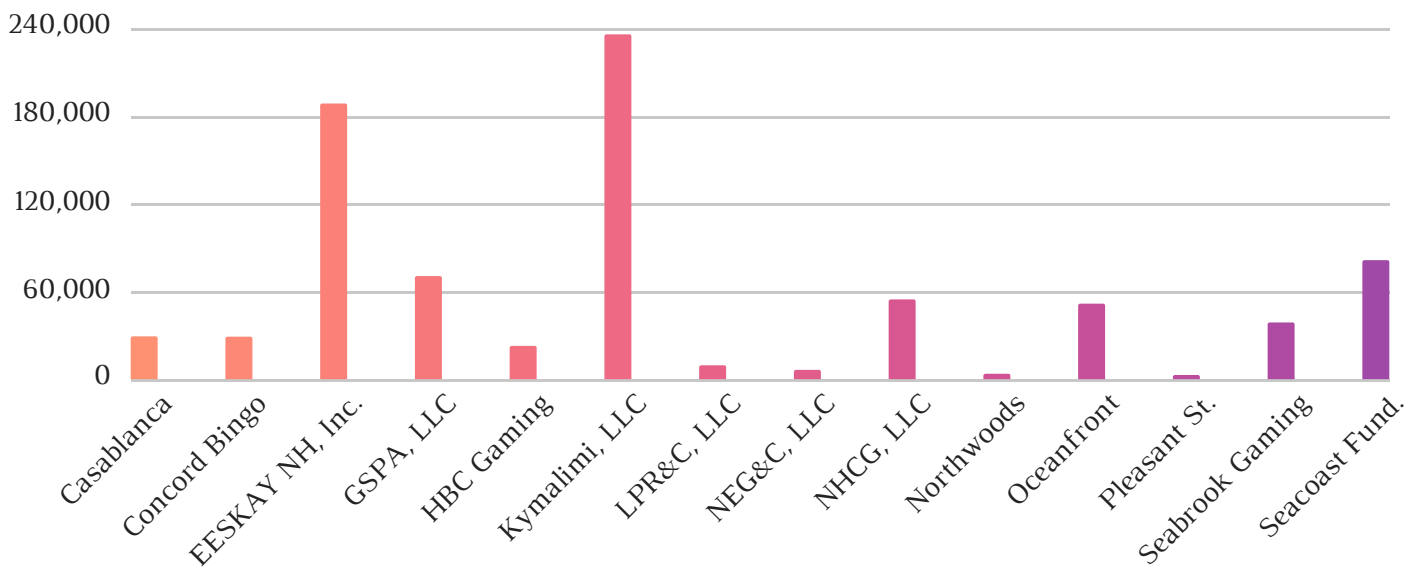
