Players open three windows on the back of the ticket. Winning symbol combinations are identified on the front of each ticket. All instant winners are determined by matching three identical symbols. There is a total of \$105 in instant winners in each deal.

There are also 15 “Hold” tickets that contain a Horse numbered 1 though 15, inclusive. The Horse winner (\$100) is determined by the first vertical column (the downline) to be called on the bingo board (e.g., for Horse 9 to win, the numbers B9, I-24, N-39, G-54 and O-69 would be called prior to any other vertical column being called.) It is only possible for there to be one “downline” winner of the \$100 prize. In the graphic below, Horse number 9 was the downline winner.

There are also a total of 450 bingo ball symbols in each game of Lucky 7 tickets (B1 through O75 inclusive). There are a total of 150 unique tickets within each game, each bearing three different bingo ball symbols. The style of play to determine the winner of the bingo event prize is the first person to have all three of his or her bingo ball symbols called during the course of the game immediately following the sale of the deal of the tickets. This person will win \$200. Balls will continue to be drawn from the bingo machine until winners are determined for all parts of the game.

Finally there is a bonus jackpot element to this game which starts off at \$200. In the example above, if Horse

9 is the downline winner and the winner of the bingo event winning ticket contains B9, then the bonus jackpot would be split between the two winning ticket holders (\$100 each). In the same example, if the bingo event winner does not contain B9, then \$200 is added to the bonus jackpot for the next deal sold. The bonus jackpot increases by \$200 for each deal until the Horse Winner and the Bingo Event winner both contain the same number at which point the bonus jackpot is split on a 50/50 basis between the two ticket holders. When this occurs, the bonus jackpot for the following deal sold will revert to \$200.
