

Manchester Hold Em Bonus

Objective of the game:

The players will combine their two down cards with a community board in an attempt to make a better five card poker hand than the dealers two down cards produce.

Rules of the game:

The player makes an Ante wager, plus an optional Bonus bet.

Two hole cards are dealt face down to the player and dealer. The player may look at his own cards.

The player must either fold or make a Flop bet. The Flop bet must be two times the amount of the ante.

Three community cards (the Flop) are dealt.

The player may do nothing or make a Turn bet. The Turn bet must be exactly equal to the ante bet.

A fourth community card is dealt (the Turn).

The player may do nothing or make a River bet. The River bet must be exactly equal to the ante bet.

A fifth community card is dealt (the River).

The player and dealer each make the best five-card hand using any combination of the five community cards and his own two initial hole cards. The higher hand according to universally accepted texas hold em rankings wins.

If the dealer has the higher hand the player will lose all wagers, except possibly the Bonus bet.

If the player has the higher hand the Flop, Turn, and River bets will pay even money. If the player has a straight or higher the Ante bet will also pay even money, otherwise the ante bet will push.

If the player and dealer have hands of equal value the Ante, Flop, Turn, and River bets will all push.

The Bonus bet will pay based only the player's and dealer's initial cards, according to the pay table posted.

Equipment to be used:

Two standard 52 card decks

A cut card

Method of play:

The game will be started with a bank from the cashiers booth. Players will purchase chips either at the cashiers booth, or from the dealer at the table.

Types of wagers / wager amounts:

Ante bets will be \$2, as the forced double bet on the flop is limited by New Hampshire's \$4 maximum bet. \$1 and \$3 bets will not be allowed in order to speed up play, and simplify payout odds.

Players may place a bonus bet, which operated independently of the results of the main game, almost identical to New Hampshire Hold 'Em (approved game 12-048).

The Bonus bet can be either \$2 or \$4, and is not connected to the ante wager, or results of the community cards. See the bonus bet pay table below

Payouts and payout odds:

As stated in the rules section, if the player has the higher hand than the dealer, the Flop, Turn, and River bets will pay even money. If the player has a straight or higher (Straight, Flush, Full House, 4 of a kind, Straight Flush) the Ante bet will also pay even money, otherwise the ante bet will push.

Bonus Bet Pay Table:

A-A (Player and Dealer), Max. payout: \$500.

A-A (Player only), 30:1

A-K (Suited), 25:1

A-Q (Suited), 20:1

A-K (unsuited), 15:1

K-K, Q-Q, or J-J, 10:1

A-Q, A-J (Unsuited), 5:1

10-10 through 2-2, 3:1


House Rules applicable to all games:

All standard table games rules will be applicable to this game.

No swearing at or berating dealers or other players.

Any cards leaving the play area will be considered dead.

Players are allowed to play multiple betting spots. Upon the establishment of a waiting list for the table, players will be limited to a maximum of two spots until the waiting list has been resolved. If less extra spaces are available than the number of players who want to play them, players will be allowed to alternate playing the extra betting spaces.
